Answers to Frequently Asked Questions:

Basic Pistol and Personal Protection in the Home – Two NRA courses combined

This is a comprehensive course designed to be an excellent review for experienced shooters and an important introduction to guns and personal protection fundamentals for everyone. The completion of these courses will enable you to obtain a Concealed Carry Permit. The following topics are introduced in this course:

- Firearms safety
- Handguns
 - Parts
 - Care and Cleaning
 - Selection
- Ammunition
- Fundamentals of shooting
- Defensive shooting
- Home safety
- Responding to a violent confrontation
- Firearms and the Law

a. Typically, the **schedule** is this:

- **Friday** evening 6:30 until 9:30PM – Classroom (3 hour law course is taught here)
- **Saturday** – 8AM until 5PM – Classroom. Hourly breaks and lunch for about an hour
- **Sunday** – 8AM until 2PM – Shooting Range. No lunch break.

b. You will need to provide these things for yourself:

- **Gun** (Your own or borrowed from someone you know.) You may bring more than one pistol if you like. It must be:
 - .22 caliber or larger – up to .45ACP. It does not have to be the firearm you will use for personal protection, but this will be an excellent opportunity to become very familiar with that gun.
NOTE: IF YOU ARE PLANNING TO USE A .22, PLEASE CALL US FIRST.
 - If equipped, you should be able to open and close the cylinder, open and lock a slide, cock the hammer and operate the trigger. Don't worry if you're not proficient at these things, but ensure you've brought a gun with you that you are physically capable of operating. It should also be:
 - Clean and in good working order
 - A malfunctioning firearm that cannot be easily fixed on the range may make it necessary for you to continue your training at a time when your gun is working. A gun that cannot finish the course means that you may not be able to finish the course until you have a functioning gun. Accommodations for you to finish will be made as space is available in future months.
 - Able to make it safe (slide able to lock open)
 - Multiple magazines or speed-loaders are encouraged
- **Ammunition**
 - 250 total cartridges for the gun(s) that you will be shooting
 - Full metal jacket or lead round nose, however:
 - No hollow points
 - No magnum loads
 - No reloaded or home-made ammunition
- **Eye protection**
 - Prescription eyeglasses are okay, but inexpensive safety glasses that cover your eyeglasses are better.
- **Hearing protection**
 - Ear plugs or muffs – or both. Indoor ranges are loud.
- Something to write with and paper for notes
- Lunch on Saturday (there are restaurants in the area. The classroom will be closed and locked during this time.)
- Dress in layers at the range. It can be cool in there. It is suggested to bring a ball cap, wear comfortable close-toed shoes, and a close-neck shirt.

c. Bring your gun with you on Saturday in a box or carrying case. We will have a dry-fire session. This means that we will be practicing all of the fundamentals of shooting *without* firing ammunition.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT BRING AMMUNITION INTO THE CLASSROOM. ENSURE THAT YOUR FIREARM IS UNLOADED. DO NOT BRING ANY AMMUNITION WITH YOU AT ALL UNTIL SUNDAY.

Registration and Last-Minute Cancellation Policy

Owing to the heavy demand for our Basic Pistol, Advanced Pistol, and Instructor Classes we adopted the following policy regarding registration and last minute cancellations:

Registration: We will not accept class registrations based on a student's promise to pay and register. To be placed in a class or on a class wait list we must have received both the student's completed and legible Class Registration Form and the Class Registration Fee. Once the student's registration and payment have been received, the student will be notified in time to attend the assigned class.

Cancellation: Last minute cancellations frequently leave class vacancies that cannot be filled. The following cancellation policies will be followed for cancellations occurring within 72 hours prior to a scheduled class:

- If we are able fill the vacancy, we will refund all but \$10 for processing.
- If we cannot fill the vacancy, will refund all but \$50.
- If we cannot fill the vacancy and the student wishes to transfer his/her registration to a future class, there will be an additional \$50 processing charge and no refund.
