

I dont need to carry a reload

RULES: IDPA Rules

START POSITION:

Seated in driver seat with hands on tape marks on steering wheel. Head facing straght forward looking over steering wheel. Gun loaded to division capacity and placed on pasenger seat. Barrel pointed toward T3. PCC start is the same as pistol start. All reloads placed on the barrel.

SCENARIO:

You have just returned home from work and found that there is a gang attacking your family. And they have broken into your home. Of course you never carry a reload with you. But you know that there are extra mags sitting on the table just inside the front door.

PROCEDURE:

At the audible signal engage T1 through the open window of the pasenger side door. Then exit the vehicle and engage T2 & T3 with 2 rounds each. Advance around the rear of the car to SP2 and engage T4-T7 with 2 rounds each from either side of the barricade. Engage S1 with 1 round. Steel must fall to score. S1 activates T6 a double drop turner.

SCORING: Unlimited

ROUND COUNT: 15

TARGETS: 7

DISTANCE: 5-20 yards

SCORED HITS: Best 2 hits on T1-T7. Steel must fall to score.

PENALTIES: Per the current IDPA rulebook

CONCEALMENT: Yes

NOTES: Driver side door starts open.
