Set Up: Coaches should plan to arrive at CESC at least one hour prior to the start of the class to set up the stages.

**Steel Challenge:** "Smoke & Hope" SC-103 goes in Bay 14. In CSEC Conex 1 are the labeled 2X4 sticks, bundled together along with the stacked base stands, top caps, 1-1/2' X2' plates, 12' stop plate, aiming cone, white spray paint and brass tarp. The 3' square shooting box is on the north side of the IDPA single door shed. Sticks are labeled 3A thru 3E with A on the left of the array and E on the right. Red stick for the stop plate is in the middle. No need to nail down the shooting box. Tarp will need nailing on four corners.

USPSA Stage: 4-4' walls, 2-wall couplers, 4-8' fault lines, 2-4' fault lines, 6-target stands, 6-wall stands, 12-5' target sticks and 7-USPSA targets in the double door USPSA shed. If setting up the stage the day before nail everything down. Minimum nail down fault lines and wall stands for same day set up. Half nail or use tires for target stands depending on wind.

**IDPA Stage:** 1-8' wall, 2- wall stands, 6-target stands, cable with cotter pin release, 2-8' fault lines, 1-4' fault line,10-5' target sticks, 4-4' target sticks, 1 steel popper, 1 drop turner and 8 targets (7 threat and 1 non-threat) in both Connex 3 and IDPA single door shed.

Set-up Equipment: APG Conex 3 there are nail bucket, hammers, crow bars, stapler and staples and bucket with black, white and brown tapes.

Before class start time: Greet students, check them in. Collect \$10 if they have not paid. Make sure they are not carrying a loaded gun. If so, take them to side berm and unload them.
